Advise on preparatory steps when traveling to/via the Netherlands

<Before departure>

We advise you to contact the airline you plan to travel by as some companies make additional requests, e.g. demanding the submission of a so-called fit-to-fly document.

We advise you to check all relevant requirements and start well in advance of your journey so as to allow sufficient time for compliance with the following requirements, where applicable:

- 1. <u>Rabies vaccination</u> Blood sampling and the antibody titration of rabies need to be undertaken at the clinics and the MAFF's designated laboratories.
- 2. <u>Microchip insertion</u> It is recommended to check whether the microchip is readable, before the day of export inspection.
- 3. <u>Application for Documents</u> <u>EU veterinary certificate</u> and <u>Owners declaration form</u> in case of non-commercial movement.
- 4. <u>Application for export inspection</u> Please contact <u>the Animal Quarantine Service</u> in time for application for export inspection

We advise you to look carefully at the specific requirements for commercially and non-commercially kept pets.
