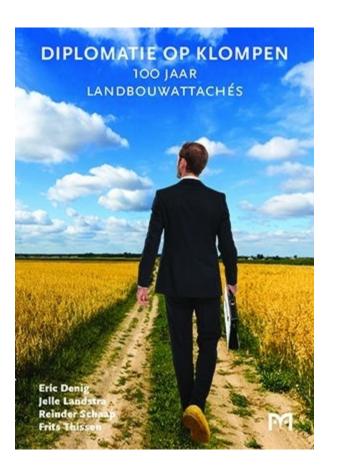


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The Agro Team

To promote and facilitate the Dutch Private Agro & Food Sector



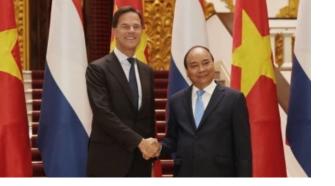

- Message to be determined per theme and activity (e.g. trade fair seminar)





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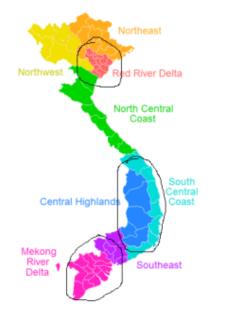
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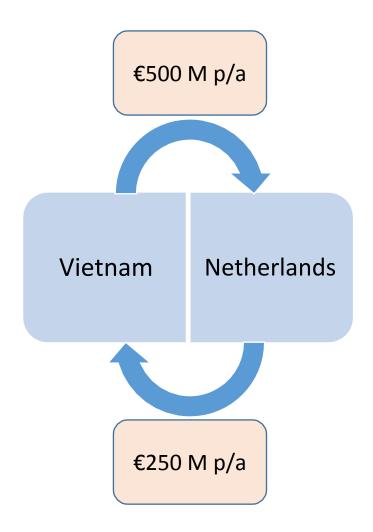

Agricultural Transformation Program



- Climate Adaptation through Agro-Water-Nexus approach → ATP is the agro part.
- Steer and coordinate the necessary agricultural transformation Mekong Delta
 - Implementation Res 120 and MARD Masterplan
 - Swift from intensive rice production to high value crops (like shrimps and fruit)
 - Swift from volume targets to value chain development
 - Based on sustainable and circular principles
- Sustainable and prosporate Delta with business opportunity's for Dutch Agro-Food-Water-Logistics-Energy sector.

Circular agriculture: what is the importance of circular agriculture and the ambition of NL?
 Important topics Vietnam (post harvest losses, reduction antibiotics, herbicides and pesticides, acknowledge farmer with fair prices, landscape approach/biodiversity, agro-water, use of waste products)
