for approving the procedure on approving the flights that fall under art. 10 paragraph (1) of the Military Ordinance no. 7/2020

Art. 1. - The procedure for issuing the approval for the flights provided by art. 10, paragraph (1) of Military Ordinance no. 7/2020 [...] - provided in the annex to this order, is approved.

Art. 2. - This order is published in the Official Gazette of Romania, Part I and enters into force on 13.04.2020.

Procedure

issuing the approval of flights that fall under art. 10(1) of Military Ordinance no. 7/2020

Art. 1. - The approval for the flights for the transport of seasonal workers from Romania, hereinafter referred to as passengers, which is covered by art. 10 paragraph (1) of the Military Ordinance no. 7/2020, is issued by the Ministry of Transport, Infrastructure and Communications (MTIC), through the Romanian Civil Aviation Authority (AACR).

Art. 2. - In order to obtain the approval mentioned in art. 1, the airline operator sends a request to AACR, at least 48 hours before the scheduled flight time, which will contain the following information:

- a) the name, address, contact details, nationality and ICAO code of the airline operator;
- b) type, registration signs/symbols and capacity of the aircraft;
- c) the airports of origin and destination, the route;
- d) the operating program;
- e) name, address, tour-operator contact details;
- f) copy of the charter contract in Romanian or English translation;
- g) the agreement of the Romanian airport regarding the flight;
- h) the agreement of the handling agent from the Romanian airport;
- i) statement regarding who is the responsible person, present at the Romanian airport where passengers embark, in order to ensure the observation of the rights of passengers, including the accommodation of passengers in case of cancellation/delay of the flight, until passengers are boarded for the final destination or, as the case may be, for transport back home;
- j) the name, address and contact details of the recruiting agent(s) in Romania;
- k) a copy of the approval of the authorities of the country of destination, for performing the respective flight, in Romanian or English.

Art. 3. - The AACR issues the requested approval within maximum 24 hours from the receipt of the complete documentation.

Art. 4. - AACR does not approve flights which are scheduled to be performed at the same airport, at an interval of less than 4 hours between them.

Art. 5. - AACR powers [...]

Art. 6. - (1) The transport of passengers to the boarding airport in Romania shall be organized by the recruiting agent, that is a legal entity authorized according to applicable regulations.

(2) The recruiting agent is responsible for providing protection equipment against COVID 19 for all passengers.

(3) The recruiting agent will arrange transportation to the boarding airport only after receiving the agreement from the respective airport manager. Passengers using other means of transport other than those provided by the recruiting agent will be informed, in a timely manner, regarding the possibility of traveling to the airport.

(4) The recruiting agent is obliged to ensure the presence at the Romanian airport of one representative to provide permanent assistance to passengers, including in the situation of delay or flight cancellation. The contact details of the representative are communicated to the administrator to the airport at least 24 hours before the flight.

(5) The road passenger transport operator shall only board passengers who are properly equipped (protective mask and gloves), in compliance with the legal provisions in force.

Art. 7. - The journey to the airport will be organized so that the passengers do not arrive at the airport more than 4 hours before the flight time, regardless of the means of transport used.

Art. 8. - The operator of road passenger transport, who carries these occasional transport services, notifies the Romanian Road Authority regarding this transport service, according to the applicable procedures. [...]

Art. 9. - The State Inspectorate for Control in Road Transport controls the conduct of road transport to / from the airport [...]
