HORTIKULTURA

Ministry of Trade Regulation No 30/M-DAG/PER/5/2017 (Permendag 30/2017) as amended the last time by Permendag 64/2018

Inspections related to horticultural products are carried out after passing the customs area (Post Border)

Importers must submit a self declaration stating that the import requirements are fulfilled before the imported goods are used or traded.

Animals and animal products are competitive and sensitive commodities in Indonesia and are subject to inspections by quarantine.

Health and food safety considerations are regulated by related ministries, such as Ministry of Agriculture



Produk Hortikultura : Garlic, Shallot, Chili, Fresh Fruits, Fresh Vegetables



Import of Horticultural Products can be done after obtaining Import Permit



Verification by Surveyor: Import must be verified at the loading port of the country of origin

REQUIREMENT FOR IMPORTER

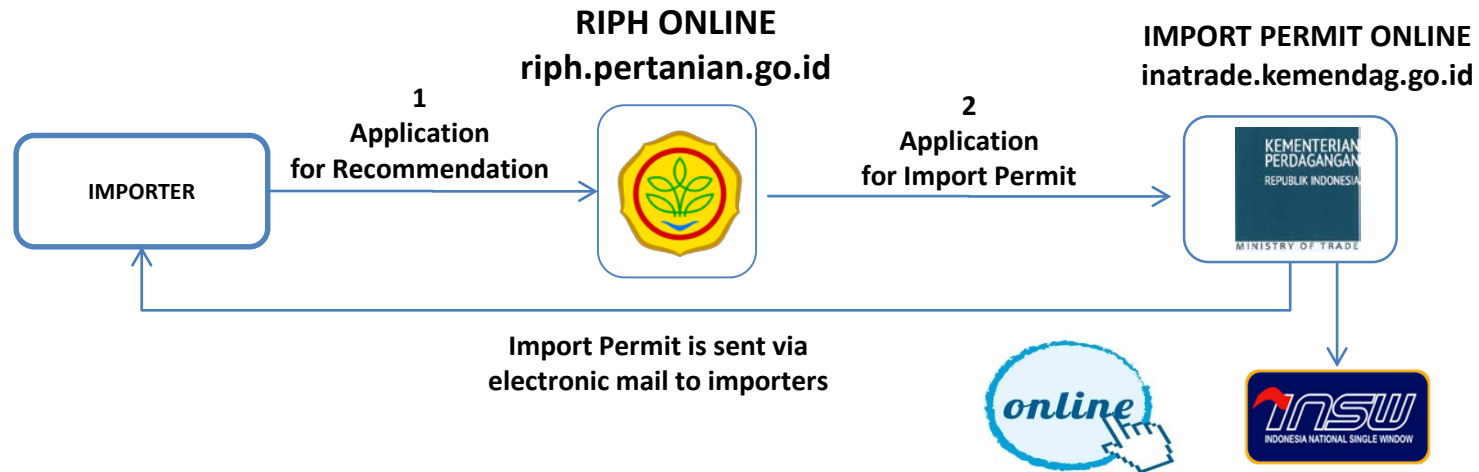
1. Importer Identification Number
2. Proof of ownership or contract of cold storage
3. Proof of ownership of transportation
4. Declaration of capability and feasibility of storage and transportation
5. Import Plan
6. Distribution Plan
7. Recommendation of Import of Horticultural Products from the Ministry of Agriculture

REQUIREMENT FOR IMPORTER-PRODUCER

1. Importer Identification Number
2. Proof of ownership or contract of cold storage
3. Proof of ownership or contract of transportation
4. Import Plan
5. Recommendation of Import of Horticultural Products from the Ministry of Agriculture

- Application for Import Permit may be submitted at any anytime
- Electronic application through inatrade.kemendag.go.id
- Imported horticultural products must be labeled and meet packaging requirements
- Validity period of Import Permit is corresponding to the Recommendation by the Ministry of Agriculture
- To guarantee good handling, capability and feasibility of storage and transportation is taken into account in determining quantity of import

PROCEDURE FOR ISSUANCE OF IMPORT PERMIT OF HORTICULTURAL PRODUCTS



Realization Report
Companies submit electronic reports on the implementation of imports, whether realized or not, no later than the 15th of the following month

Issuance of import permit: no later than 2 working days from the date the application is received completely and correctly



ANIMALS AND ANIMAL PRODUCTS

Inspections related to animals and animal products are carried out after passing the customs area (Post Border)

Ministry of Trade Regulation No. 59/M-DAG/PER/8/2016 (Permendag 59/2016) as amended the last time by Permendag 65/2018

Importers must submit a self declaration stating that the import requirements are fulfilled before the imported goods are used or traded.

Animals and animal products are competitive and sensitive commodities in Indonesia and are subject to inspections by quarantine.

Health and food safety considerations are regulated by related ministries, such as Ministry of Agriculture and National Agency of Drug and Food Control/NADFC (BPOM)

IMPORT OF ANIMALS AND ANIMAL PRODUCTS

Appendix II of Permendag

1. Animals of the type of ox (i.e Cow)
2. Meat of bovine animals (fresh/chilled)
3. Secondary Meat Cut
4. Premier Meat Cut
5. Meat Industry Cut
6. Variety Meat Cut

REQUIREMENT FOR IMPORT PERMIT

1. Importer Identification Number
2. Deed of Establishment and its amendments.
3. Proof of ownership of maintenance site and slaughterhouse, or proof of cooperation contract with slaughterhouse (for animals)
4. Proof of ownership of cold storage and transportation (for animal products)
5. The weight of feeder cattle that can be imported maximum of 450 kg
6. Recommendation from the Ministry of Agriculture

Appendix III of Permendag

1. Animals other than type of ox (i.e. Horses)
2. Poultry (Chicken, duck, turkey)
3. Other live animals (rabbits, birds)
4. Pork, Lamb, Chicken meat
5. Processed Animal Products (Milk, Yogurt, Whey, Butter, Cheese)

REQUIREMENT FOR IMPORT PERMIT

1. Importer Identification Number
2. Recommendation from the Ministry of Agriculture
3. Recommendation from National Agency of Drug and Food Control/NADFC (BPOM)

- Application for Import Permit may be submitted at any anytime
- Electronic application through inatrade.kemendag.go.id
- Import can be done only from countries that are free of animal diseases
- Imported animal products must be labeled and meet packaging requirements
- Validity period of Import Permit is corresponding to the Recommendation by the Ministry of Agriculture
- Monitoring through post-audit mechanism





MILK

Permendag 59/2016 as amended the last time by Permendag 65/2018 also covers milk and dairy products

The increasing demand of milk is a positive sign of economic growth in Indonesia. Imported milk is one way to meet this demand, together with domestic supply which yet to be improved.

Another solution is to import dairy cows which are productive in producing fresh milk.

Under the current regulation, dairy cows may be imported to Indonesia with no prohibition, as long as the requirement in the application of import permit is full filed.

Indonesia has been improving its system of importation, both in horticultural and animal products, to address concerns by WTO members.



Ministry of Trade has done a total of 5 revisions on the Minister of Trade Regulations concerning importation of horticultural and animal products. This step is taken with the aim of being fully compliance with WTO agreements.
