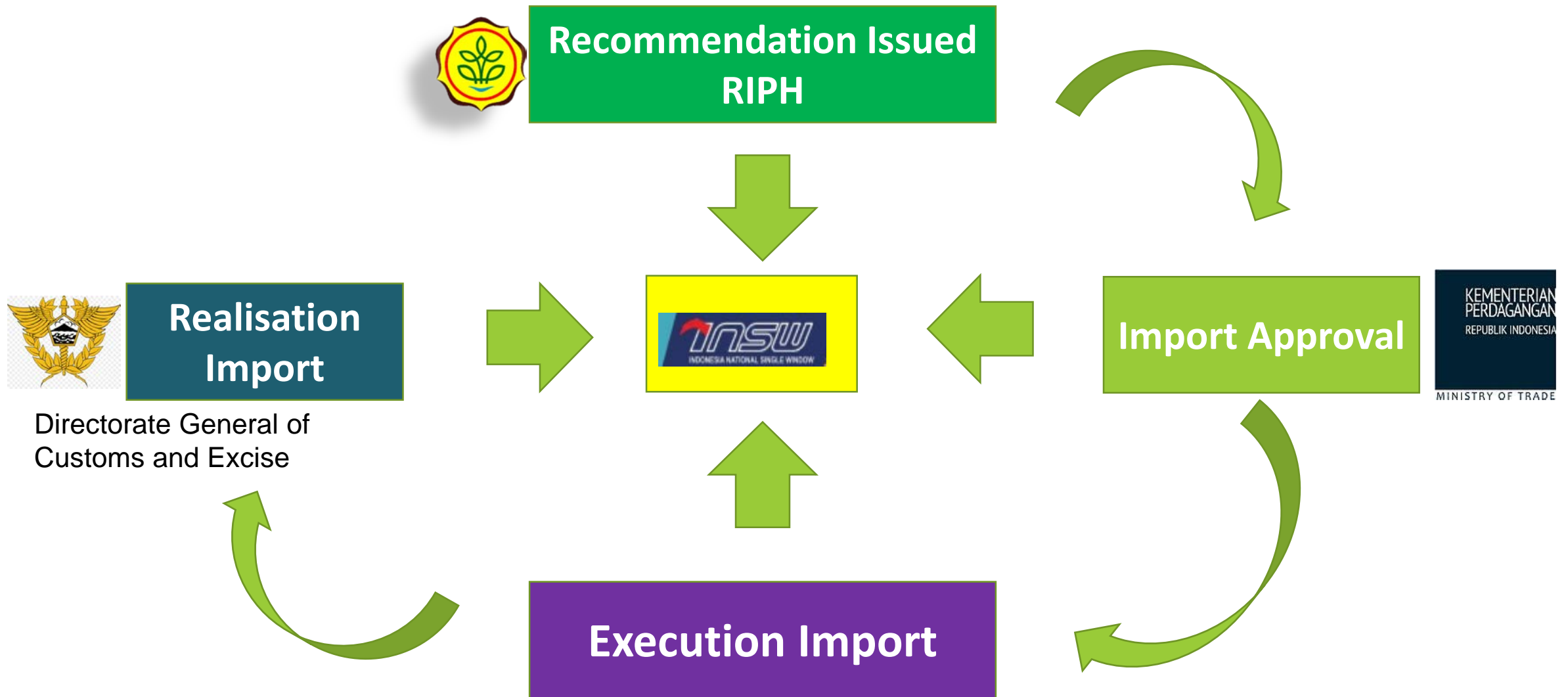

THE PROCESS OF ISSUING HORTICULTURAL PRODUCT IMPORT RECOMMENDATION (RIPH)



CURRENT RIPH REGULATIONS

The Regulation of Minister of Agriculture No. 38 Year 2017 regarding Horticultural Product Import Recommendation, issued on November 23th, 2017

The Regulation of Minister of Agriculture 24 Year 2018 regarding The Amendments of The Regulation of Minister of Agriculture No. 38 Year 2017 regarding Horticultural Product Import Recommendation, issued on June 6th, 2018

RIPH REQUIREMENTS

ADMINISTRATIVE REQUIREMENTS:

- certificate of company establishment, and its latest amendment,
- tax identification number (NPWP),
- identity card (KTP) of the head of the company,
- information of the company domicile,
- importer identifier number for general trade (API-U),
- importer identifier number for industry (API-P),
- statement letter of not selling horticultural products that have been imported to the general market for Business Actors with API-P,
- recapitulation report of the previous horticultural product import realization,
- stamped statement letter which declare that the submitted documents are correct and legal.

RIPH REQUIREMENTS

ADMINISTRATIVE REQUIREMENTS FOR GARLIC: besides the above requirements, there are subsidiary arrangement as follows:

- a) statement letter of competence for garlic cultivation development domestically;
- b) statement letter of garlic planting plan which recognized by the district/city department head who organized agriculture related government affairs; and
- c) realization report of garlic planting domestically for those who have done planting activity which recognized by the district/city department head who organized agriculture related government affairs.

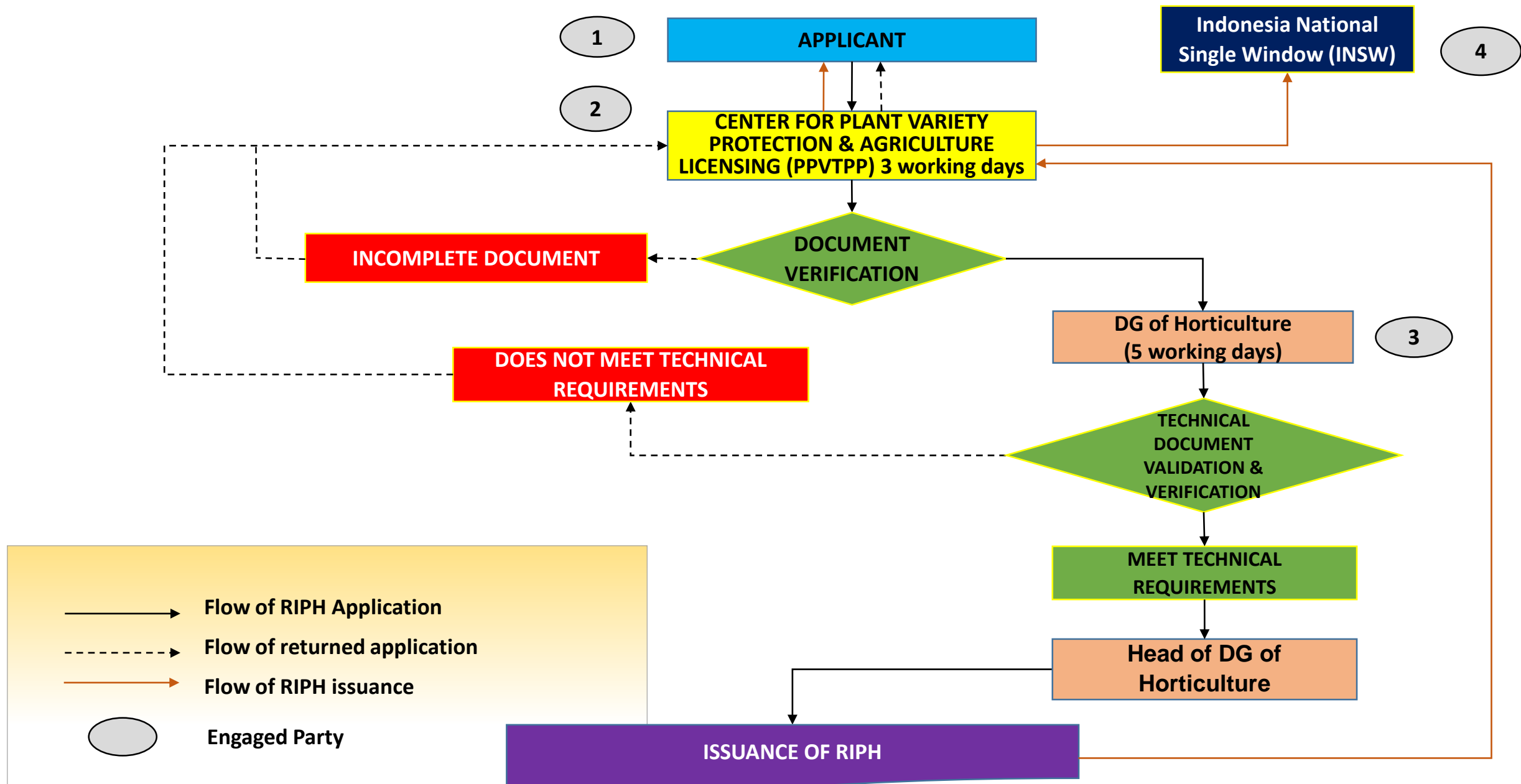
RIPH REQUIREMENTS



TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS:

- a) Fresh Horticulture Products must fulfil the safety requirements of Plant Based Fresh Food (PSAT);
- b) Fresh Horticulture Products that are imported for the first time from its country of origin must be equipped with the result of risk analysis of quarantine plant pest organism (AROPT) from the Agricultural Quarantine Agency;
- c) Good Agriculture Practices (GAP) certificate or other equivalent certificate that is internationally recognized and still valid until the end of the import period;
- d) Packing house registration that is published by the authorized agency in the country of origin that is still valid until the end of the import period;
- e) Certificate from the origin exporter country regarding production capacity of the orchard/plantation that have been registered or certified of Good Agriculture Practices/GAP; and
- f) The horticulture products that could be imported fulfil the specified characteristics.

GARLIC RELATED REGULATIONS

Article 32 :

1. Business Actors who perform the Import of garlic horticultural products must develop the planting of garlic within the country;
2. Development of the planting of garlic can be done by themselves or in in cooperation with farmer groups; and
3. Further provisions concerning garlic planting development is determined by General Director decree.

Article 33 :

1. The planting of garlic by Business Actors is preferably done on new area;
2. The planting of garlic is performed for a maximum period of 1 (one) year after issuance of RIPH; and
3. The planning of garlic must be reported to the Director General with recognition from the Head of Agricultural District/city Services on the planting location

GARLIC RELATED REGULATIONS

Article 36 :

1. The planting of garlic must at least produce 5% of the volume of the RIPH requested per year;
2. The planting area required to produce 5% is calculated based on the average productivity of 6 (six) tons per hectare; and
3. Business Actors who applied the next RIPH must submit report on the realization of garlic planting and production.

PROVISIONS OF SANCTION

No.	Violation of the provisions	Sanctions
1	API-P holder selling horticultural product to general market	being denied RIPH for 1 (one) year and withdrawal of the Horticulture Products from circulation
2	Not realizing garlic plantation commitment domestically within 1 year after RIPH issued	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Proposing to ministry of trade for import volume reduction - being denied RIPH for garlic for a maximum of 2 (two) years if violating 2 (two) times in a row
3	Not submitting recapitulation of import realization; and incorrect & invalid submitted document	being denied RIPH for a maximum of 1 (one) year
4	Not submitting import approval letter (SPI) to Ministry of Trade	being denied RIPH for a maximum of (one) year
5	No import realization	being denied RIPH for a maximum of 1 (one) year for Horticulture Products with import that have not been realized
6	the Horticulture Products that have been imported do not fulfill the specified characteristics	Sanction according to the legal provisions in the field of customs
