


Sustainability as a business opportunity



What is a circular economy?

The circular economy is a production and consumption model in which products and services are designed to enable sharing, reuse, repairability and recyclability. Unlike a linear economy, where resources are overexploited and waste is generated, in the circular economy, scarce resources are used efficiently and the value of the products does not end up being buried in a landfill. The circular economy is trying to reflect natural processes where no waste is produced. Waste is seen by the circular economy as a resource that we return to circulation, creating a closed loop of materials, products and components.





Importance of circular economy

Why are we thinking about the circular economy?

New legislative requirements and regulations – Circular Economy Action Plan 2015, Single-Use Plastics Directive 2018, European Plastics Strategy in the circular economy 2018.

The current linear model of the economy leads to waste. Slovakia achieves below-average resource productivity among EU countries. This means that we can generate less economic value from the kilogram of material used.

Changing customer preferences – more and more Europeans are willing to pay a prime for eco-labeled products.

Dependence on suppliers of raw materials or other countries due to lack of own resources, which may have negative consequences for business (e.g. high input prices).

Legislation is gradually tightening in favor of the circular economy. Through training and consulting we want to help companies prepare to inevitable changes.

What benefits brings the circular economy?

- Reducing the burden on the environment and less greenhouse gases
- Reducing the risk of distortion and price volatility of raw materials supplies
- Increase of productivity and competitiveness
- Innovations in a production process that brings further efficiency gains and savings costs
- New business opportunities and opening opportunities to enter new markets
